Dear church family and friends,

America has a fiercely independent DNA. Much of the thirst for freedom was fueled by the lack of freedom in England: spiritual, political and economic. This independent spirit can be so strong that when anyone gets close to "infringing" on our freedom,

we push back out of fear of losing our freedom.

Ironically, too much independence can threaten our freedom and prevent working together when necessary. Our nation struggled as 13 separate colonies formed one nation under our Constitution. States feared giving up independence to a national government. It became clear, however, that they could not stand against England unless they united. In signing the Constitution, each state acknowledged dependence on the federal government.

What we learned from that experience was that there was a need for balance between independence and dependence, freedom and cooperation. Genesis says we are created in the image of God and have free choice. We are individuals and communities. Each individual choice affects other people. Adam's original sin affected Eve, especially when he blamed her for his sin. After that episode, Adam and Eve had to figure out how to work together and be together for the rest of their lives.

We wrestle with the balance between independence and dependence at all levels: families, friends, churches, communities, towns, counties, states, and countries. We need the individual ideas and energy of each person. But, necessary cooperation can only take place as we give up some freedom to a greater good. Some things can only be accomplished by working together.

As we face challenging times in our region, may all people seek constructive ways to work together to meet the economic, social, and spiritual needs of our county. As we all pray and work together, may our larger community one day not just survive, but thrive.
