Since mankind showed up, stories were used to form relationships. The great stories of the Bible were passed by word of mouth before they were written down. Since they are now in the Bible, we can participate in these wonderful stories of God relating to His people.

We, at Wise Baptist Church, have a story to tell. It is the story of a local church in Wise, Virginia. It is the story of God working in and through this people.

One place which can tell our story is the annual church budget. Let's look at one budget item. The amount budgeted for electricity was \$18,500. Our first impulse is to see whether we have spent more or less. Let's look behind the numbers. Electricity provides for lights, air conditioning, and power. This allows a place to gather, pray, organize, and then minister inside and outside of our three buildings.

In July, ministries supported by the budgeted electricity item:

- Disaster relief mission trip to New Jersey
- Remote Area Medical (thousands touched)
- Vacation Bible School (over 100 children plus families). The Vacation Bible School mission project gathered 152 book bags for school children.
- The "Ride, Run, and Relax" event (and other events) helped raise thousands of dollars to assist Ian Boggs, a local 6 year-old boy with special needs.
- The Brown Bag Ministry our church made and delivered 1,500 lunches.
- Regularly scheduled activities such as Sunday School and morning worship.

The next time you see a budget, think of the ministries the numbers support. Thank you for your giving! Your giving makes a difference in the lives of people. As we stand on the edge of a new church year, let's take part in God's grand invitation to walk with Him in ministry and missions about His wondrous love.
