Hearts all over America are breaking over the tragedy at Newtown, CT. Nothing seems more fundamentally wrong than the intentional hurting of innocent children. As different as people are in so many ways all around the

world, one thing we would assume we could agree on is not intentionally or injuring children.

This seems to turn everything upside down. A boundary has been crossed that makes us shudder. The world suddenly seems a more dangerous place. We fear for the future. What will this mean for every child, parent, and grandparent?

In our shock, anger, and grief, we are looking for answers, some explanation that will help us understand. Deep down, we hope that understanding may help us "fix" this. Our hearts are broken. We want an easy answer and a quick fix. It is our way of wanting to take control of what seems spinning out of control.

First, pray for the families touched by this tragedy in Newtown, CT that God will touch their hearts. Pray and discern ways to address a complex problem with many causes. There is no quick and easy fix.

It is a time to grieve, to pray, to reflect, and then to move one step at a time to take appropriate precautions to create a safer world for our children.

It is ironic, that the Creator of all things came in the most helpless of forms...a child...a tiny baby. That child grew up to become our Savior and lay down His life for us.

This Christmas, when we do not have the answers, we are compelled to go to the One Who is the Answer. John 14:6 says that Jesus is the "Way, Truth, and Life".


