Sometimes Communion can become routine. Once something becomes routine, we do it and stop thinking about it. Communion can become that kind of routine since we have it every month. Over the months ahead there

will be an effort to help us think about and reflect upon its profound meaning.

Pictures do speak a thousand words. Images, figures of speech, and symbols are signposts of greater realities. Images in the Bible speak of great and eternal realities. There are images that speak powerfully about Who Jesus is. One image is of Jesus as the Door.

Last Sunday, the table upon which the Communion elements sat, was an actual door sitting on two sawhorses. Another door was sitting upright so it could be



better seen. Part of the idea is about Jesus being the door for us. He is the Doorway from us to God. He is the Doorway to life eternal. The Lord's Supper reminds us of the sacrifice of His body and blood to forgive our sins and purchase our salvation. The Lord's Supper in the early church was part of a common meal.

Jesus is the also the Gracious Host, Who invites us to the table. Henri Nouwen says that around the table an "enemy can become a guest" and we can experience a renewed sense of family in Christ.

I invite you to anticipate and pray that we will meet Jesus in each Communion and find refreshment of Spirit, renewed love for God, and service for Him.
