Dear friends.

Today, we will continue the theme of forgiveness and reconciliation introduced in the story of Jacob and Esau. It involves both asking and giving forgiveness well.

To ask forgiveness well, there are several important parts. Recognize how we have hurt others. Genuinely apologize. Ask how we can make it right. Think about why we did it, so we might avoid repeating the same mistakes or sins.

Then, we must learn to offer forgiveness well. That means to forgive the other person in our hearts. Wait for them to ask your forgiveness before you offer it to them out loud. Recognize the difference between forgiveness and reconciliation. You can only do your part. It takes both sides doing their part to achieve reconciliation.

Further, make sure that you have the facts right. Sometimes we can be holding on to unforgiveness that is based entirely or partly on incorrect information. Finally, tell the offender how they can repair the damage, if they are interested in doing so.

Reconciliation is a miracle. Greater still is the miracle of reconciliation that God offers us through the sacrifice and death of His Son!
