#### Dear Friends,

The human body is amazing! We tend not to pay too much attention until something about our body is not working. The Bible says in Ps. 139:14 that we are "fearfully and wonderfully made."

Dr. Paul Brand (1914-2003) was born on the mission field in India. He returned to England when he pursued a medical career. His medical field work was combat surgery during World War II. In addition to being a surgeon, he was a dedicated servant of God, as indicated by the title of his biography, "Ten Fingers for God."

Listen to his description of the amazing body that God has created. He asked the question, "Have you thanked God today for your red corpuscles (blood cells) today?"

He answered, by saying, "You would not even be here without them. These little red cells start out in a great gush of red and leap from the ventricle of your heart into the 8-lane highway of the aorta. Then, they swim like crazy to the 4-lane brachial artery. Next, they take a 2-lane road to the exit ramp, where they find the first little lane followed by a narrow footpath of a vessel before they come to the culvert of a capillary. There, they fold themselves double and crawl into the capillary, dump oxygen, sweep up the trash and then hurry off to the liver, the spleen, the kidneys, and the lungs. Then, when they are once again bright red with oxygen, they jump back into the ventricle of your heart and are off again."

Instead of complaining about what is not working in our bodies, a better approach might be to thank God for how wonderfully our bodies have worked for so long.


