Dear friends,

The Bible is packed with the language of relationship. Ideas of friends and family fill its pages. So it is with life...that relationships with friends and family fill and significantly impact our lives. Rollo May estimates that we deal with anywhere from 500 – 2,500

acquaintances, but on average have only 7 friends in any given year. Those numbers give pause for reflection. We often do not stop long enough to reflect on whether we are gathering acquaintances or friends. There is a limit to how many close friends we have time to cultivate, but I suggest that most of us probably need more than they have.

It is interesting that Jesus poured and invested His whole ministry into the hands of twelve people. These were twelve people who had spent time with each other and Jesus for three years. Night and day for three years the disciples absorbed, witnessed, and practiced what Jesus believed and taught.

I Samuel 18 reveals a beautiful friendship between David and Jonathan. They made a “covenant” between each other. It is a sacred bond. The same word, covenant, is also used to describe God’s special relationship with His people.

A great place to cultivate and extend spiritual friendship is the local church. A great place within the local church to experience friendship is in small groups of some kind. A small group that meets often allows you to get to know people and for them to get to know you. On Wednesday nights we will have three opportunities in 3 different studies: a men’s study, women’s study, and a book on parenting (grandparents can benefit, too). There will also be youth Bible study and Bible study for children. Sunday School has classes for all ages and meets each Sunday.

Jesus, in John 15, calls us friends. May we extend that spiritual friendship in all directions.


