Dear Church Family and Friends.

Has your prayer life become inconsistent or stale? Do you want to inject new life into it? How? One word. <u>Listen</u>. Listen to God.

Prayer is a conversation with God. Talking and listening...50% of each. What if your friends talked for 90% of your conversation? It would be rude. Would convey that what you had to say was unimportant.

Now, transfer that idea to your conversation with God. What is missing? Listening. How does that affect your spiritual life?

How do we fix it? Think about how you practice good listening with someone.

Focus your attention. Remove distractions. Privacy. Learn to be comfortable with quiet. Read your Bible, which shows what communication with God looks like. Include quiet inspirational music. Write down what God shows you.


