Dear Church Family and Friends.

Someone says that pain can be a "life coach". How we pay attention to pain can make a difference. In the fall of 2012, I had severe intestinal pain. I had already been to the ER in Staunton (as we were on our way home to Wise). Tests were inconclusive.

Several days later, I had the same kind of intense pain. I spent hours trying to decide how much I should pay attention to it. Should I load up with Tums and aspirin? Should I make another trip to the ER, only to get inconclusive results? Finally, I decided to go the ER in Norton. The doctor on call diagnosed it correctly, saying I needed surgery as soon as possible.

The surgery was successful. It has been almost six years and there has been no re-occurrence.

That was pain to which it was worth paying attention. Sometimes if we continue to have the same pain, it seems almost "normal". It could be a broken relationship, a health problem, a decision we have put off.

Some pain is an alarm calling for immediate correction of the problem. Other times, we need strength to live with it. It is important to know the difference. Either way, the Holy Spirit can speak in ways we might not otherwise hear. Either way, we need the Holy Spirit to help us discern which kind of pain it is. Either way, we need God's guidance and help.

What are those pockets of pain in your life? In what way do we need the Holy Spirit to guide, teach, and fortify us?


