Annie Dillard, in Pilgrim at Tinker Creek, tells a fascinating story about special markings that American Indians put on their arrows. They were called "lightning marks". They were grooves cut down the length of the shaft for a purpose.

When the Indians hunted, sometimes they would strike their target with an arrow. Then, their prey would run so far away that they could not find it. The lightning marks allowed the blood to flow down the shaft to leave a blood trail. This would allow the Indians to track and find their prey.

Now...back to Bethlehem. There is a blood trail, hinted at in Bethlehem. This trail became a reality when Jesus shed His blood and died on the Cross for all. The lightning marks of the sin and brokenness of all humanity make a trail that leads us from Bethlehem to the Cross.







The Bethlehem Carpentry Shop is a busy place. Many folks travel here to learn how to construct their own wooden nativity scene.




