Paul Harvey used to have a show called "The Rest of the Story". He told something familiar about a famous person and then provided details that greatly enriched the story.

"Dr. Livingstone, I presume" was a famous statement. It came from a man who found the

missing famous Scottish explorer/medical missionary, Dr. David Livingstone, who was presumed dead.

And now..."the rest of the story". Dr. David Livingstone finished missionary training in 1857. Dr. Robert Moffat, a missionary from South Africa, said he saw "in the morning sun the smoke of a thousand villages where no missionary had been." 
