Over the past few months our church has explored what the church means. A careful study of the New Testament indicates that a commitment to God includes a commitment to and through other believers. The only practical way we can commit to other believers is

through the local church.

A central idea in the life and ministry of Jesus is the Kingdom of God. Simply put, that means the rule of God and all that goes along with it. It is about proclaiming, living, and encouraging others to acknowledge His leadership.

The book we have been studying on Wednesday nights, "I am a Church Member" contains a commitment at the end of each chapter. If you have not read this book, you can pick up a copy in the sanctuary or church office. I urge you to read it carefully and then to pray about your commitment.

There is a poster in the sanctuary listing these commitments. A number of people have already signed their names to it. As you have opportunity, I urge you to prayerfully consider signing your name.

After signing the commitment poster, each person takes one piece of the puzzle. That puzzle piece is a reminder that we are connected to God through Christ and also to each other. That puzzle piece is a reminder that there is a place for you and you have a part. It takes all of us to be the church. The poster and puzzle will be in the sanctuary for the next few weeks to allow others to take this step.

RECOMMENDED READING: COLOSSIANS 3:15-17



WEDNESDAY NIGHT MEAL AND BIBLE STUDY

We will **NOT** automatically cancel our activities because Wise County or Norton City schools are closed.

The decision to cancel our activities will be made no later than 2:00 pm and will be communicated through email, website, Facebook, and phone calls.
