Dear church family and friends,



A river outside its banks creates chaos. A river within its banks creates blessings whether for transportation, leisure, shipping of goods, etc.

Seasons of worship are like river banks, guiding the flow of worship. They remind us about themes of faith. Advent (four Sundays before Christmas) prepares us for Jesus' birth. Lent (six weeks before Easter) prepares us for His resurrection.

The current sermon series, "Encounters with Jesus", introduces us to people who meet Jesus, face to face, on His way to the cross. They are also companions for our journey as we prepare for Easter.

Yesterday, we met Zacchaeus, a chief tax collector with authority over other tax collectors. Tax collectors could charge whatever they wished. They could stop any traveler, go through all of their things, assess the value, and collect a tax. If one could not pay, they might loan the money and charge outrageous interest. Or, they might throw you in debtors' prison and seize your property.

Zacchaeus was not hated; he was despised! Yet, in his heart was a desperation that all of his wealth could not satisfy. Here we have a grown man in a long robe running to see Jesus. He does not stop there. He even climbs a tree to get closer to Jesus!

After meeting lesus, he proclaims he will give half of his wealth to the poor and pay each person four times the amount he has cheated them. By my calculation, Zacchaeus was now broke, financially. But he was spiritually rich beyond measure and rejoiced!

May we, like Zacchaeus, be desperate for God, Who can enrich us spiritually, beyond measure!

The Virginia Baptist Foundation offers scholarships each year to full-time students who are members of BGAV churches. Students must have a minimum GPA of 3.0 & apply or re-apply each year.
