Do you have memories that are locked in your mind? One of mine occurred in 2010 when I learned that my great-great-grandfather was a slaveholder. One of his slaves, Charles Crawley, said my great-great-grandfather "had about fifty head of colored people". He was treated and even thought of himself as livestock.

That was a shock to read that my own family directly participated in slavery. It is easier to be horrified now. It was widely accepted then. It is difficult to accept that slaves were property. People could be bought, sold, and treated however the owner wished with no protection by law.

This meant a slave lived in fear, because their lives were always in jeopardy. Our country has lived in fear since 9-11. Ever since the Twin Towers and the Pentagon were attacked, we have been afraid. National security and terrorism dominate the news and our thoughts.

We cannot live this way. We cannot live as God intends. We cannot control what happens outside us, but we can control what happens in us (with God's help). Difficult times can cause us to wall up our lives like a fortress. The goal becomes to prevent anything bad from happening to us.

Our focus becomes our fear instead of God. Allow difficult times to drive us to our knees. Allow fear to cause us to trust God more. Allow fear to compel us to be the church...to go to all the world with the love of lesus.

Today is a great day to be a Christian. Today is a great day to be a light, not hidden under a bushel, but out where all can see.

Let's be the light of Jesus!
