Dear Church Family and Friends.

All the world has watched the drama unfold about a Thailand boys' soccer team and coach trapped in a cave with rising flood waters. A massive rescue operation resulted in good news...all twelve boys and their coach were rescued!

They went for a hike into a cave. They were trapped 2.5 miles deep into the cave as flood waters rose. Time was running out.

The conditions seemed hopeless. Risks were high. The boys could not swim. They were weak from lack of food and the cold. The water was murky. The current was strong. The passage was narrow, so narrow that each air tank had to be removed so that each person could go through the passage.

Hundreds of experts from around the world gathered to help. Water was pumped out. Experienced divers stepped in. The cost was great...one expert diver drowned. However, the courage and expertise of the divers and others helped enable a miraculous rescue.

An even greater rescue operation took place over 2,000 years ago. The situation was hopeless. Mankind was deeply lost in fear, anger, greed, bitterness, hopelessness, and selfishness. All of history declared that this was a permanent human condition. There were no signs, humanly speaking, that it was going to get any better.

God's rescue operation that had been planned before the foundation of the world was put in place. The cost was great...God's only Son, Jesus, sacrificed His life to save us from our sin. Luke 19:10 says, "...the Son of man came to seek and save the lost.






