

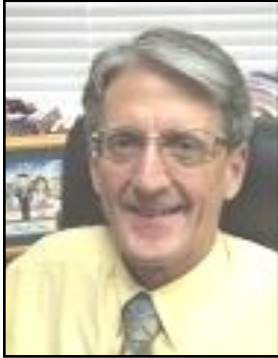

Dear Church Family and Friends,

A few months ago, a controversy erupted in the NFL. Ryan Tannehill, quarterback of the Tennessee Titans, said it was not his job to mentor young quarterbacks on his team.

Pushback was immediate, from all directions. Former NFL quarterbacks, current players, coaches, commentators, etc. weighed in.

You can boil down the pushback into a single idea. Mentoring is indispensable.

What is it? Mentoring is the process of sharing wisdom with someone who needs it. It comes from someone who knows more about it.

Who are the mentors who have shaped and blessed you? They listened, challenged, encouraged and walked along with you. Where would you be without them?

There are mentors all the way through the Bible. Moses was mentored by Jethro. King David by the prophets Samuel and Nathan. Elijah mentored Elisha. Jesus mentored the disciples. Barnabas mentored Paul and John Mark. Paul mentored Timothy.

Every Christian can and should be a mentor to an individual or a group. You do not need a title. You do not even need a formal agreement with the person(s) you mentor.

You can pray for, encourage, share wisdom in the areas where you are a little further down the road, spiritually. Allow this process to challenge you to continue to grow in your own faith. Pray for God to put the ones He wants you to mentor on your heart.

You were blessed by mentors. Extend that blessing to others.
