Thank you for supporting and sending us on mission to Tarboro, NC! On Saturday, June 23, forty-eight souls left Wise on a spiritual adventure none of us could have anticipated. Each day offered surprises, opportunities, learnings and grace!

The blessings of God from that week are God used every member of our group, to provide overwhelming. something the larger group needed. Paul captures this idea in I Corinthians 12:6, "There are different kinds of working, but the same God works [in] all of them." There was the gift of laughter, teaching, encouragement, discernment (of needs of others), mercy, faith, love, challenge, etc.

Our mission team included far more than the people who physically went to Tarboro. The prayers and resources provided by our church in Wise were vital. Without this support, we never would have gotten out of the town of Wise!

The mission projects included: roofing, community clean-up/planting, sub-flooring, electrical work, insulating, house-framing, dry-walling, building a covered porch and handicapped ramp. Time spent on each work site allowed us to get to know the homeowners.

Then, at the end of the week, twelve Bibles were given out. Each homeowner from this year and last year was presented a Bible signed by their particular work crew. The moment each Bible touched the hand of the homeowner was indescribable. The support, prayers, preparation, love of God and physical work by our team and the anxious waiting of the homeowner were squeezed into a single moment. The tears of joy flowed...

I thank God for the body of Christ at Wise Baptist Church!

RAM ~ July 20-22


