Dear church family and friends,

"How do I apply Scripture to my life?" Before we answer that question, we need to ask, "How do I get more of the message of the Bible into my head and

heart?" Until then, I will not apply it or live it.

- **Listen**. The Bible was spoken before it was written down. God spoke, people heard and wrote it down. Come with an open heart. Read the Bible passage out loud and listen as if God is speaking directly to you, because He is...
- Write. Write out the verses. It forces us to "sit with" the verses longer. It is easy to rush Bible reading. Allow time for God's truth to seep into your heart.
- **Pray.** Reflect on what God is saying and write your prayer. If my prayer is based on the message of the Scriptures I have just read, then it is in keeping with God's will. The Bible says that if we pray according to God's will, that prayer will be granted.
- **Live it.** Now we are more ready to apply the message and better able to understand how to apply it.

My challenge to us all is to allow more of God's truth to get into our hearts and minds. There are many ways to do so. Personal Bible study and prayer time are two ways. Another is Bible study with others...Sunday morning and Wednesday nights are two options.


Wise Baptist ChurchSummer Missionaries

PRAYER GUIDE FOR OUR SUMMER MISSIONARIES

JUNE 26—JULY I



Pray for our preparations and our health. Pray for wisdom for our leaders as they prepare the projects for the team and the devotionals and team building activities. Begin praying for all those we will meet and work with during our time in Gainesville. FL.

JULY 2-9

Saturday: Pray for our safety as we travel. Join us at the youth building at 5:30 am for a time of prayer and encouragement for our missionaries. Feel free to write cards or to bring goodies for the team.

Sunday: Pray for our time of worship at Greater Faith Baptist Fellowship. Lift up Pastor Dixon and his congregation. Our team will take part in the music portion of worship. *Light* will participate in worship as well. We will spend the afternoon preparing the building for renovations, gathering materials, etc.
