Dear Church Family and Friends,

When someone is suffering, what do we say? If the suffering is great, the question becomes even more urgent.

Here are some thoughts that might be helpful.

- Pray for the person and for God to help you help them.
- Manage your own anxiety. We feel pressure to say "the right thing". Recognize that there are no magic words that will take away the pain.
- Listen

A place for faith and fellowship with family and friends.

- Don't try to explain why this suffering is happening or what you think God is trying to do.
- Sometimes less is more. Our words normally should be few.
- Your presence matters. People may not remember what you say, but they will remember you were there.
- Remember what people did and said that were helpful when you were in a time of crisis.

Job 3:11-13 records the actions of Job's friends when they learn about his great suffering. There is beauty, power and guidance for us in these verses.

"Job's three friends...heard about all the troubles that had come upon him and they set out...to sympathize with him and comfort him. When they saw him from a distance, they could hardly recognize him; they began to weep aloud, and they tore their robes and sprinkled dust on their heads. Then they sat on the ground with him for seven days and seven nights. No one said a word to him, because they saw how great his suffering was."
