Dear Church Family and Friends,

How many times in your life have you heard that when someone dies that heaven gets another angel? The intention is probably to comfort the grieving. What does the Bible say? Genesis 1:27 says "God created man in his own image...male and female he created them." There is no indication in the Bible that

people change into angels.

We must also ask what is truly helpful to someone who is dealing with a death or a crisis. The Bible says that Job experienced horrific losses: his children, servants, possessions and health.

Job's three friends heard about his troubles. "When they saw him... they began to weep aloud, and they tore their robes and sprinkled dust on their heads...they sat on the ground with him for seven days and seven nights. No one said a word to him, because they saw how great his suffering was." (Job 2:11-13)

Sometimes, our silence is more powerful than our words. It can be a gift and an act of love. The gift of presence is not about easy, unsatisfying explanations or solutions to the grief at hand.

Didn't Jesus offer the gift of presence on a much greater level? He was called Emmanuel, which means "God with us". And so Jesus was with us...for 33 years on earth. He died and rose again in order that He might still be with us. He will be with us forever in heaven as we gather around His throne.

Pray about ways we can bring the presence of Jesus as we are with people who are hurting.


