Dear church family & friends,

The Kingdom of God is forever. It lives and breathes on this side of heaven and will exist in perfect harmony and obedience to God on the other side of heaven. The privilege of every follower of Jesus is to extend the rule and love of God.

The Kingdom of God is bigger than any group, church or group of churches. We can do more together than we can do by ourselves. A living picture of this idea is the Southwest Virginia Partnership (SWVP). In 2010, the Baptist associations of Clinch Valley, Powell River and Wise joined together in a partnership with the Virginia Baptist Mission Board to operate a center for mission projects to be done in Lee, Scott and Wise Counties. The projects included Backyard Bible Clubs, food pantry and construction projects (handicapped ramps, roofing, repair work, etc.).

This mission center, called "The Manor" is in Nickelsville. It is a former nursing facility that has been repurposed to house groups of volunteers coming from all over the state. It houses 56 volunteers and accommodates sleeping, showering and meal preparation. There are also six camping sites with full hook-ups behind "The Manor". The directors are Tony and Jan Johnson.

Originally, the SWVP was partially funded by the Virginia Baptist Mission Board. As of now, it is self-supporting! In the last six years the SWVP has completed nearly six hundred local projects! Hundreds of volunteers from all over the state have come to participate. Wise Baptist Church has taken an active part.

There has never been a greater need for this ministry. If you would like to take part, contact Butch Hutchinson, who is a member of the SWVP Board of Directors, or you can contact the church office.


