

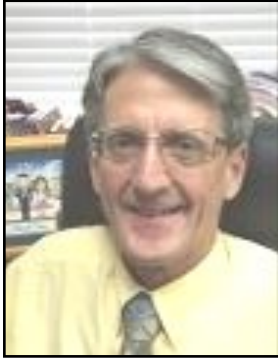

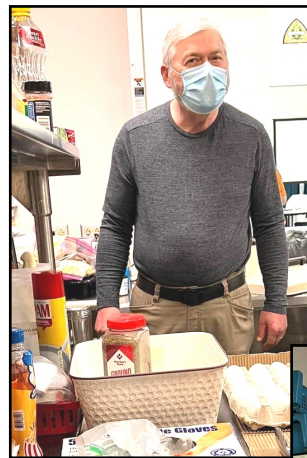

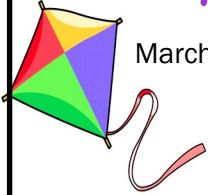
The *Garden Club* has put out a box for recycling in the Fellowship Hall.

It is for clean plastic bags, etc. Please bring your plastic bags & other plastic wrappings.

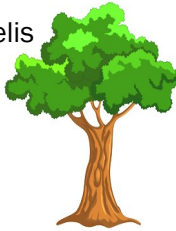
