Was it right that both groups got paid the same? The bigger point is that God offers grace. To all. Do any of us deserve it? Can I honestly say that I deserved for Jesus to die for me? That I earned it?

When we really grasp the grace that God offers, it changes us. Then, we can extend grace to someone else. Who needed it just like we did.





In my continuing article on why churches are losing their dominance in society, we covered "With Our Words" and "Complaining" last week. This week we are featuring the next four -"Entitlement", "Short-Sightedness", "Self-absorption" and "Judging".

Entitlement The church is not here to serve you, but you are here to serve the church, Jesus' domain. When we begin to feel that the church needs to serve YOUR needs, you are expecting a servant. We are placed in our church to serve others, not the other way around. Paul says in Romans 12:1 that we are to give our bodies to God for all He has done for us, be a living and holy sacrifice that he will find acceptable. Nowhere does it say that the church will serve us, but WE do the serving.

Short-sightedness How many times have you said, or at least thought "we can't do that, there's not enough of us" or "that's just too much for our little church to do"? God places people within our churches that can dream big and can enlist others to help. The vision of one can become the vision of many, but they can also big a risk and change, which many are uncomfortable with. God has called us to continually grow and have an impact. These cannot occur unless we change things up occasionally and not do the same old stuff and stagnate.

Self-absorption When we obsess over ourselves, whether it's our shortcomings or our problems, we lose sight of the mission God has called us to. Our world shrinks and instead of us growing in love, faith and service, we grow in misery. Have you found that to be true? Do you obsess over your health not being what it used to be? Do you think "I can't do that anymore"? If we continue to focus on ourselves, we become miserable and are unable to focus on God and his redemption, peace and joy in our lives and the greater impact on our church and community.

Judging We all have a bit of "Pharisee" in us and it can come out in thoughts of: bitterness, gruffness, condescension or avoidance. When someone new comes into our congregation that doesn't fit your idea of a new church member, are you welcoming or do you avoid all eye contact and run to the nearest door to get out before you have to speak to them? That sounds funny, but I see it every Sunday morning. How many times do you take an extra minute or two of your time to talk to our visitor(s) before you run out the door and head to lunch, family or a sporting event? Do you judge from what they are wearing or not wearing? Whether they have on too much makeup, not enough makeup? Too old, too young or too many children? Different color/race?

We may not feel that we do that, but is that pride that is talking instead of love? (That kinda hits home with me). We need to check our hearts each and every day and ask God to remove those things that get in His way.
