DO YOU KNOW...

HOW THE BIBLE*CAME TO BE?

- * It was written by about 40 different men
- * It took about 1600 years to compose, beginning with Moses in 1500 B.C. & concluding with John in A.D. 95.
- * The Old Testament (the Hebrew Bible) was completed about 400 years before Jesus was born.
- * The Bible is composed of 66 books, 39 Old Testament books & 27 New Testament books.
- * The chapter & verse subdivisions in the Bible & the descriptive phrases that precede certain sections are not part of the original manuscripts. These divisions were created during the 13th—16th centuries by various scholars.
- * 3 different languages were used to write the Bible: Hebrew & Aramaic (Old Testament) & Greek (New Testament).
- * The word "Bible" means "the little books".

In the front of our pew Bibles are several helps that are useful as we begin reading through the Bible this year!




