Why do we play "Taps?" This has been a question that we often ask ourselves, especially on Memorial Day. To find the reason, we must look back at the origins of the bugle call itself.

In July of 1862, General Daniel Butterfield told his brigade bugler that he disliked the colorless "extinguish lights call that was currently in use. He then whistled a new tune and asked his bugler to sound it. This went on for a few attempts and then, finally, they came up with the bugle call that was suitable for them and called it "Taps." The next day, buglers from other brigades came over to see what this new call was that had been used. They liked it, and then after copying the music, returned to their camps. Eventually, their generals also ordered it to be used to call "lights out."

General Butterfield could not have imagined its popularity and then use for another purpose for which it would grow. Today, whenever a man or woman is buried with military honors anywhere in the United States, "Taps" is played to signal "Put out the lights. Go to sleep." We use this tradition on Memorial Day to remember America's fallen. On Monday, trumpet players and buglers across the nation play taps at exactly 3:00 p.m. Tens of thousands will unite to commemorate and honor all the men and women who have fought and fallen in the line of duty.
