There was an important reason for the "Day of Service" being after Easter. There is a great build-up to Easter, but our journey does not end there. It is always "the day after Easter",

We do not accept donations. This makes it clear that we are giving with no strings attached.

It creates space for the Holy Spirit. We do not give too much information about our church to allow people room to move toward us and to respond to the work of the Holy Spirit. There is time to give more information later.

Anyone can do it!

It is fun...to see who God will place in our path and what He will do! You never know how far the ripples from acts of kindness in Jesus' name will go.

You will be *amazed* at what a difference you can make! You can bless and encourage in ways that will surprise you! The *sky is the limit*. Be creative. What small practical acts of kindness can you do to serve our community and Lord?

Let's keep the momentum going! Any individual or any small group can do this.
