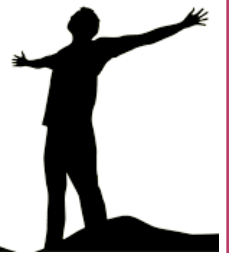

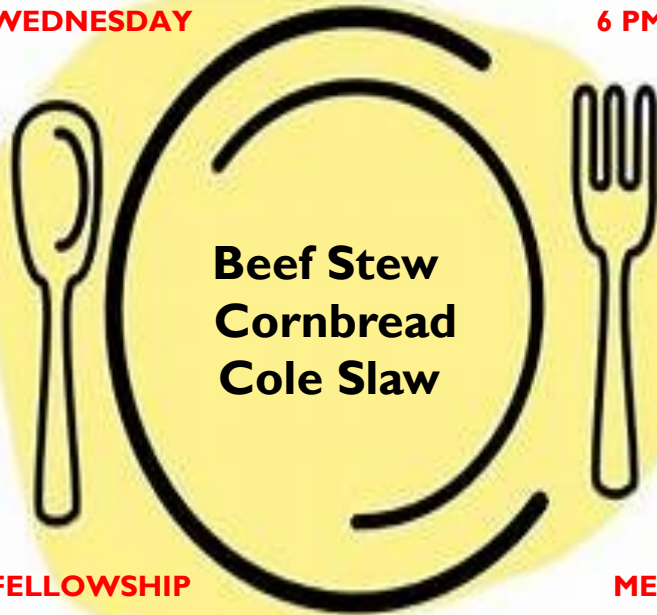

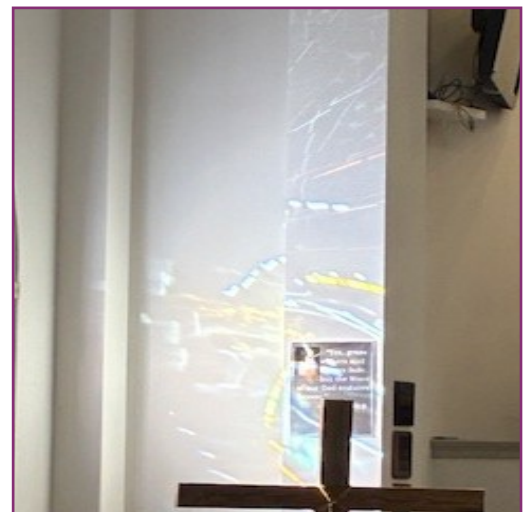

Be thankful!!

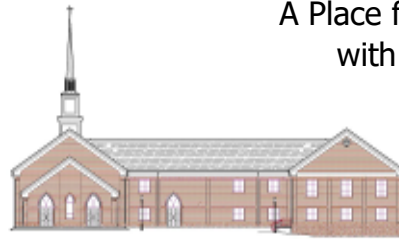
