

Dear Church Family and Friends,

Do you know your personality type? How about people you spend time with every day? This knowledge can help you grow and improve your relationships. We are exploring nine personality

types, each illustrated with a Bible character. So far, we have looked at: the Perfectionist (Paul), the Helper (John), the Achiever (Jacob) and the Romantic (Isaiah). For today? the Thinker as seen in the Psalmist.

The upside? The Thinker takes time and makes the effort to think things through. Mistakes are avoided. Wiser decisions are made. The downside? Thinkers think they must have all the answers. They have a hard time accepting it when they cannot find the answer.

The Psalmist cannot wrap his mind around the idea that evil people may prosper (Ps. 73:3). He gets lost in his anger over this injustice. We all have an instinctive expectation that life must be fair. When life is not fair, it can consume us. We see it often. Good people suffer. Evildoers not only avoid suffering, but profit at the expense of others.

The wisest people over the centuries have wrestled with this dilemma. None have come up with a good answer. The Psalmist finally concludes that it is not his job to be the final judge of people around him.

There is an important spiritual component to knowledge. Proverbs 1:7 says "The fear of the Lord is the beginning of knowledge". This "fear" means reverence and respect.

The answer? Use your mind to the fullest but yield to the One Who knows all things. Next week? The Questioner.




What is the Jesse Tree?

Each Sunday during Advent (Dec. 1, 8, 15, 22), the children are invited to come to the front of the church during worship & place ornaments on a special Christmas tree called the Jesse Tree. The tree is named for Jesse, the father of King



David. Each ornament is a symbol of a person or event that helped point the way to the coming of the Messiah. On the first Sunday, 4 ornaments will be placed on the Jesse Tree: an apple (Adam & Eve), a rainbow (Noah), a star (Abraham) & a basket (Moses).
