

Thanksgiving, while being a national holiday, holds a deeper spiritual meaning for Christians. At its heart, Christian Thanksgiving is not just about food or family gatherings, but about recognizing God as the ultimate provider of every blessing.

Scripture repeatedly calls believers to give thanks—"Give thanks in all circumstances; for this is God's will for you in Christ Jesus" (1 Thessalonians 5:18).
