Dear church family and friends,

An oft-told Bible story is about the woman who pours very expensive perfume on Jesus' head. Out of curiosity, I checked the internet on the subject, perfume". One is called "Joy Baccarat Pure Parfum". It

takes 10,600 flowers to make just one bottle of this! One can sign up to buy it monthly or quarterly, just in case you run out. The good news, however, is that the shipping is free! Be sure to order while supplies last.

The Bible says in Mark 14:1-9 that the woman broke a container of expensive perfume and poured it over Jesus' head. The perfume was equal to an entire year's salary. She also broke the container. That means she had to have used all of it. She could not put the top back on to keep any of it.

Think about how much perfume is needed to get the desired effect...just a few drops. We also know immediately when someone has used too much perfume. Imagine the power of the fragrance when the woman poured, not a few drops, but the entire container of perfume over Jesus!

There is power in the sense of smell. Certain smells bring to mind events that happened decades ago. Every single person in the house with Jesus could smell that powerful fragrance within moments. Jesus remarks about the extravagant gift from this woman - He says, "Wherever the gospel is preached throughout the world, what she has done will also be told, in memory of her."

The most extravagant gift we can give is ourselves...our hearts, minds, talents, gifts and resources. How might we give of ourselves to the Lord in return for His inexpressible gift of Himself? To God be the glory!


Is it any wonder that so many young people lose hope and some even take their own lives. Just think how hard it would be in this world if we didn't have the hope that only a relationship with God can bring.

From Leigh

I am studying Gideon with a great group of men and women each Thursday night. I love our time together. Everyone is engaged in sharing what they have learned, their own personal experiences and encouragement for each other in places of struggle.

Gideon begins his story afraid and uncertain. The Israelites are once again facing an invasion from the Midianites. Their crops and homes will be devastated. So, Gideon is hiding in a winepress threshing wheat hoping to keep it from the enemy. An angel appears to tell him that God has chosen him and is going to use him to save His people. Gideon is in disbelief because he is not a warrior. But, God assures him that He is the right guy for the job!

The enemy has an army that is 135,000 strong. Gideon has 32,000 soldiers. God tells him that he has too many! So, Gideon's army is dwindled down to 300. God knows that the Israelites will take credit for the victory if they believe they can defeat the enemy in their own strength—their pride would overcome their recognition of God's strength.

I believe God knows this of all of us today as well. We are so quick to believe that we can handle situations and then we become prideful instead of humble. God wanted Gideon to know and He wants us to know that we need Him in every area of our lives. God gives us strengths and yes, we should use them. But, He also makes us weak so that we realize we need Him.

"But he said to me, 'My grace is sufficient for you, for my power is made perfect in weakness'. Therefore I will boast all the more gladly about my weaknesses, so that Christ's power may rest on me. That is why, for Christ's sake, I delight in weaknesses, in insults, in hardships, in persecutions, in difficulties. For when I am weak, then I am strong." (2 Corinthians 12:9-10)

I give thanks for each of you and for this church. I am praying for you this week; pray for each other, too.


