Dear Church Family and Friends,

The will of God...seems to be this mysterious detailed plan for our lives that is always a little of out of reach. Part of the problem may be the way we think about it. We assume that there is a lot

about God's will that we do not know. We then assume that our lives are somewhat on hold until we do know this mysterious plan.

The will of God is simply what God wants. How do we know what God wants? We get to know Him. How do we get to know His will? One way is to read the Bible. Much of God's will is already revealed...in the Bible!

One example is in I Thess. 5:18, which says to "give thanks in all circumstances, for this is God's will for you in Christ Jesus." Suppose that verse is my Bible reading for the day. It says that God's will is for me to give thanks in all circumstances. Now, what are the circumstances in my life right now, **in which** I need to give thanks?

For example, my children live in San Francisco. I wish they lived closer to Terry and me. Does the Bible say to give thanks for that? No, it says it is God's will to give thanks in that circumstance. I can be thankful that they have jobs, that they are healthy and they have an opportunity to stretch themselves in new ways. I can be thankful to God that this is an opportunity for me to depend more on God.

Maybe it would help to focus on what we do know God is saying to us instead of what we don't know.




