Today we are going to be looking at one of the hymns that we sang

this past Sunday. "I Heard the Voice of Jesus Say" is a hymn that was written by Horatius Bonar. Horatius was born in Edinburgh, Scotland (1808) & was the son of a ruling elder in the Church of Scotland. Horatius decided to follow in his father's footsteps & became part of the ministry himself.

Not long after he had entered the ministry, there was a large disruption in the Church of Scotland that had resulted in 451 ministers being removed from the Established Church. Bonar & a number of his friends together formed The Free Church of Scotland. Horatius' church had no substantial library of hymns, so he naturally began to write. He especially found that the youth of his church had a love for either the words or the tunes that they grew up with, so he set out to write a few hymns with simpler lyrics.

"I Heard the Voice of Jesus Say" was one of the hymns Horatius wrote during his time at the church. This is possibly his most famous song, not only being popular in Scotland, but also in the English-speaking world. The song is set to an old Celtic tune called "Kingsfold." It is not clear when this tune was composed, but it was well received by the youth as well as other members of the church due to the familiarity that it brought. Horatius also set the tune to the familiar passage of Matthew 11:28-30.

I heard the voice of Jesus say, "Come unto Me and rest; Lay down, thou weary one, lay down Thy head upon My breast."

I came unto Jesus as I was, weary and worn and sad; I found in Him a resting place, and He has made me glad. I heard the voice of Jesus day, "Behold, I freely give The living water; thirsty one, stoop down, and drink, and live."

I came to Jesus, and I drank of that life-giving stream; My Thirst was quenched, my soul revived, and now I live in Him.

I heard the voice of Jesus say, "I am this dark world's Light;

Look unto Me, thy morn shall rise, and all thy day be bright."

I looked to Jesus, and I found in Him my Star, my Sun; And in that light of life I'll walk, till traveling days are done.

I hope that all of you have a wonderful week. Never forget to stop and listen once in a while, you never know what melodies you may hear.


