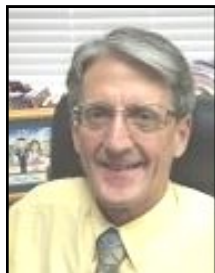

The second person is **an encourager** (like Barnabas). Barnabas and John Mark were on Paul's first missionary team. John Mark jeopardized Paul's entire mission when he bailed out at the very beginning.

Paul finished the first missionary tour and began organizing the second. Barnabas asked Paul if John Mark could join them. Paul rejected his request. Barnabas, however, did not give up on John Mark.

Paul later changed his mind about John Mark. He wrote these words from prison... "Get Mark and bring him with you because he is helpful to me in my ministry." (II Tim. 4:11)

Because of Barnabas' encouragement, we have in the Bible a book called the Gospel of Mark! That is the power of encouragement!

Pray about building a consistent encourager into your life.

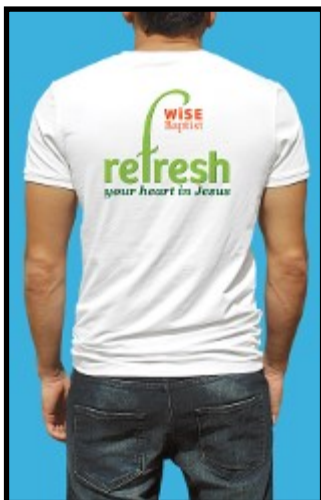

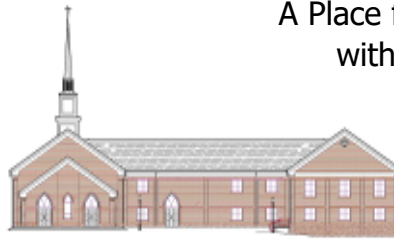
