Dear Church Family and Friends,

The Book of Revelation...a source of mystery, confusion and debate. Some avoid it because it is hard to understand. Others study it more than any other book in the Bible. To complicate things even more,

there are many good, Christian people who disagree on the interpretation of Revelation.

I want to focus on one theme upon which all Christians might agree. **The Book of Revelation is a book about worship.** Worship should be a central part of our lives on earth and in heaven.

John announces in Revelation 1:10-11, "On the Lord's Day, I was in the Spirit and I heard behind me a loud voice like a trumpet, which said, "Write on a scroll what you see and send it to the seven churches..." ". John is in the act of worship when God inspires him to write the Book of Revelation. When John sees God as He is, he falls at His feet.

Every chapter in Revelation declares God as Someone Who inspires wonder and awe. "He is the Alpha and Omega" (beginning and end) – Rev. 1:8. "His hair is white as snow and eyes like blazing fire. His feet like bronze glowing in a furnace and His voice was like the sound of rushing waters" (Rev. 1:14-15).

Throughout Revelation, God issues decrees for all the world from His majestic throne. Surrounding His throne are the 4 living creatures who never stop declaring, "Holy, holy, holy is the Lord God Almighty, who was, and is, and is to come." (Rev. 4:8).

A good starting place in worship is to approach God with awe. This is what the Old Testament means by the phrase "fear of the Lord". When we see Him as He is, we see ourselves as we are...and we see our needs.


