Dear church family and friends,

How does spiritual growth happen? Sometimes, we think of it as things that happen to us on the outside . If these things occur and support me, I will grow.

When Jesus was getting ready to begin His ministry, the devil intercepted Him. The devil tempted Him

three times.

The second temptation was for Jesus to prove that He was Savior by publicly jumping off the Temple over a deep valley. This would force the angels to rescue Him. The devil reasoned that this would "wow" the crowd to follow Him.

What if Jesus had jumped off the temple and angels had swooped down in front of great crowds to rescue Him? They would have been awed, amazed, and overwhelmed. What if hundreds then declared that they were going to follow Jesus?

What, then, would be the basis of their faith? What would they expect as a follow-up? How often would they need or depend on these external miracles to prop up their faith? Would their faith be in the miracle or in Jesus, Himself?

Faith is not blind. There are facts that support our faith. The order and beauty of nature point to God. There is another important fact: the disciples, who ran for their lives before the crucifixion of Jesus, later risked their lives after Jesus' resurrection. There are the facts of our own experiences that point to God. The emptiness of life without God, points to the One Who can fill that emptiness.

But...finally, we must make a decision in our hearts – on the inside. We cannot expect and depend on miracles and big displays of God's power to feed and support our faith. That is not true faith. Faith is risk and trust. It is a daily decision.

Join us for a special time of worship as we reflect on the meaning of Passover and how Jesus fulfilled God's promises through His death and resurrection.

We will observe a Passover meal from a New Testament point of view. The Passover celebration was an anchor that helped hold the people of God together throughout their history. Every object in the service: the candles, yeast, bitter herbs, unleavened bread, and the four cups are loaded with meaning that beautifully tells the story of God and His people.
