Dear Church Family and Friends,


This Sunday, April 4, is Donna Hutchinson's last Sunday as our Music Director. Joe McNulty will begin on April 11. More information is coming.

Kathy, Rachel & Sarah Helton will be happy to add your flowers to the cross.




