Dear Church Family and Friends.

The greatest battle we face today is between our own ears. What? That's right. Inside your head. Your thoughts.

Your thoughts shape your feelings. Those feelings shape actions. Then, they direct behavior.

It's not obvious. The thoughts are underground. Outside of awareness. But they are always at work.

Three basic thoughts play havoc with us:

You are helpless. (There is nothing you can do...)

- You are worthless. (You have no value. Your shame and guilt define you.)

The message of the gospel counters each of these three thoughts.

- "I can do all things through Christ who strengthens me (Phil. 4:13). This counters "I am helpless".
- "God so loved the world that he gave His one and only son" (John 3:16). This counters "I am worthless".
- "He first loved us" (I John 4:19). This counters, "I am unlovable".

Don't let unexamined thoughts define you. Instead, be defined by the thoughts of the One Who loves you beyond measure!

- 4. You can "sign up" by contacting the church office or using your Communication card in your Sunday bulletin.






March Cakewalk!
