Dear Church Family and Friends,



How many times have you heard (or said), "God won't put on us more than we can handle."? Maybe more than we can count. It sounds spiritual. It even sounds Biblical.

It is one of those "default" ideas we fall back on, especially in difficult times. Because the idea seems so reasonable, we may not step back to reflect upon it.

Since we have the time, let's take a closer look. There are three separate ideas in this phrase I would like to explore.

- "God won't put on us"... This implies that God "puts" on us every difficulty in our path. This makes Him the cause of everything that happens, even sin! This sounds like predestination, which says that God has already decided everything that will happen. It eliminates free choice. That even implies that God makes me choose Him.
- "...more than we can handle". It sounds like God calculates how much we can handle and stops just short of our breaking point. That makes God sound cruel. This is not the God, Who, out of love, sent His only Son for us.
- "...we can handle". This makes it sound like it is all up to us. If it were all up to us, then there would have been no need for God to send Jesus on our behalf.

What the Bible does say is that God gives us the dignity of free choice. The Bible says that God loves us so much that He sent His Son to die for us. The Bible says that He does not leave us on our own, but sends the Holy Spirit to teach, comfort and empower us.

That is good news! Let's spread the word!






