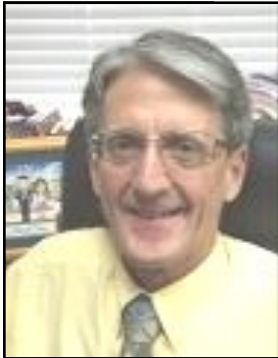

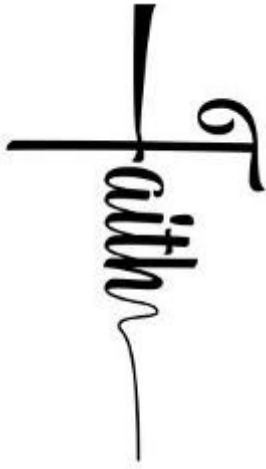


*Scripture

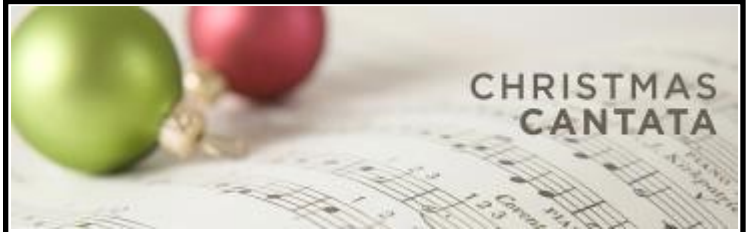

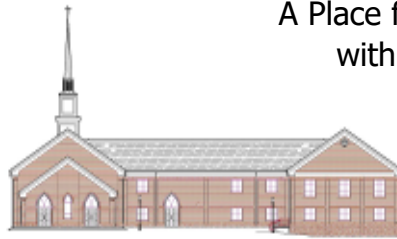
