Dear Church Family and Friends,

Jealousy...the last fifteen years of King Saul's life were dominated by jealousy. King Saul knew his rule was coming to an end. He also knew his replacement was David, who lived in his own palace! Every time he saw David, he was reminded of losing his crown. His jealousy became so intense that he tried to kill David with his spear (I Sam. 18:10). Saul tried to kill David six times over these years!

Jealousy can happen in our lives, too. The path to full-blown jealousy happens in steps. The door opens when someone has what we want. Then, we decide we need it. Then, we decide we deserve it. Finally, we decide we cannot live without it.

What forms can jealousy take? Someone else got the promotion, award, grade or recognition that we thought we deserved. Someone has nicer clothes, a nicer vacation, car or home. Someone else has the kind of relationships we wish we had in our lives.

Jealousy can lead us to believe the problem is outside of us, as Saul did. David was not the problem. David's presence only reminded Saul that something was missing in his relationship with God.

When we are jealous, something is out of balance. We hope these things can fill spiritual needs that only God can fill.

Jealousy is not the issue. Jealousy only reveals a deeper issue in my own heart. It is an occasion to submit all that I am and all that I have to God, Who will supply all my needs through our Lord Jesus Christ.

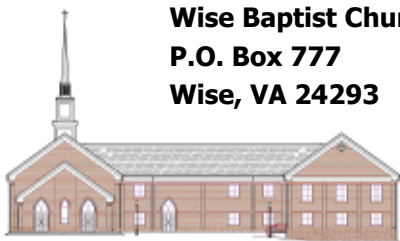
