### Dear church family and friends,

On Sunday, while we worshipped at Wise Baptist Church, the people worshipping at First Baptist Church in Sutherland Springs, Texas had a very different experience. A gunman burst in, killing 26 and wounding 20. As I considered what to write in this column, I first felt at a total loss about where to begin.

Details flooded my mind. How could someone do this? Innocent people, small children, pregnant women? During a church service? So soon after 59 were killed and 515 wounded in Las Vegas? The two worst shootings in America only 36 days apart?

The finger pointing has already begun. Some say the answer is more gun control. Others say the answer is less gun control and better enforcement of existing laws. The solution is not simple. It rarely is.

Something in our system is not working. I don't know exactly what it is or the best political solution. I do know that finger-pointing is not the solution. It is easy to blame someone else. That lets me off the hook about doing my part.

The Bible says Christians should be good citizens. Jesus says to "render to Caesar what is Caesar's and to God what is God's". Appeal to lawmakers to work together to come up with solutions instead of demonizing the opposing party. We could also create a better political atmosphere by not demonizing other politicians or parties.

Pray for the families who have experienced horrific losses. Be an active, informed private citizen. Also, remember, Jesus said in John 8:12, "I am the light of the world". There is no darkness that can put it out. The Light shows up best in the darkness and calls all people to a better Way.



### WEDNESDAY NIGHT MEAL AND BIBLE STUDY

We will **NOT** automatically cancel our activities because Wise County or Norton City schools are closed.

The decision to cancel our activities will be made no later than 2:00 pm and will be communicated through email, website, Facebook, and phone calls.

Your safety is most important. Please don't attempt to get out if the weather/conditions are dangerous.

### SUNDAY SCHOOL AND WORSHIP

We will have Sunday School and Worship even during inclement weather. The exception to this will be if our building is without power.

Our Pastor and Building Stewards will make that decision, if necessary.
