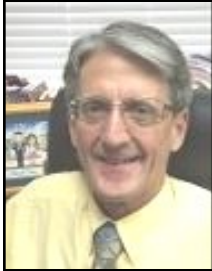

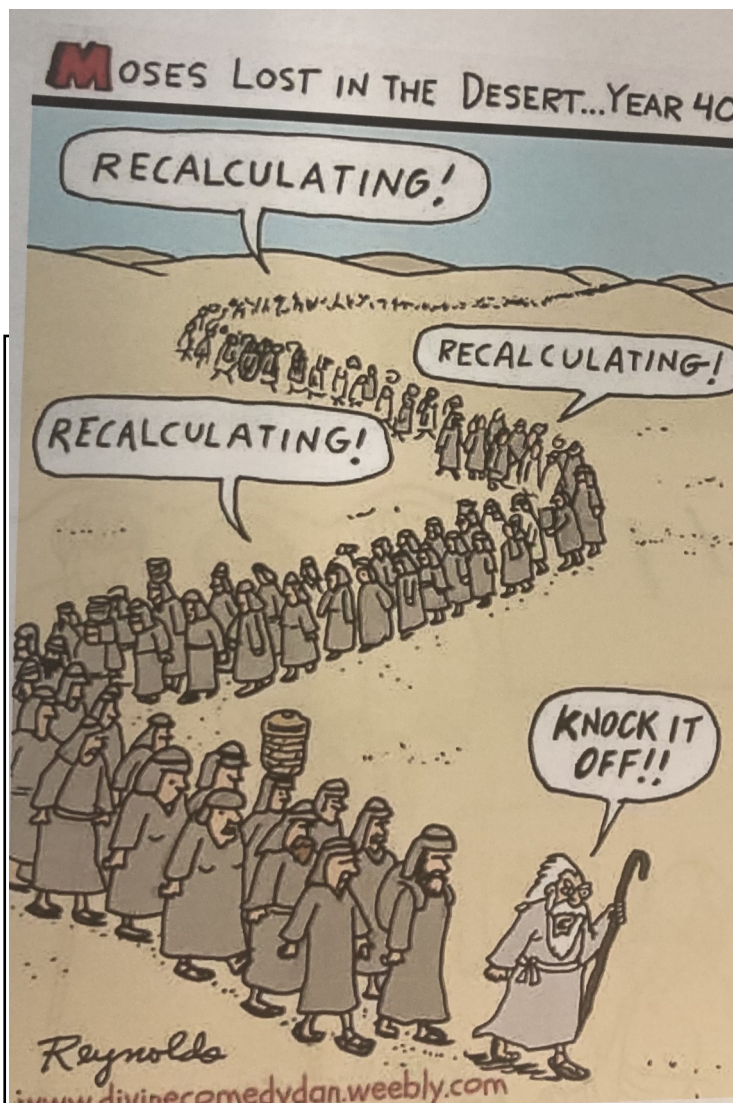
While the world looks upon me

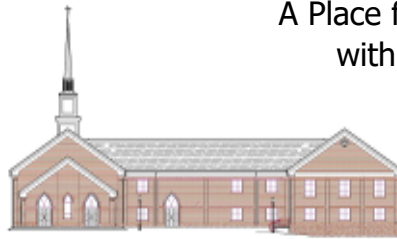
