"Our world is worse than ever!" How often have we heard (or said) those very words? If we believe the world is worse than ever, then what? We may think there is

nothing we can do. We become discouraged and lose hope.

Moses might challenge the statement that the world is worse than ever. Consider the world into which he was born. For hundreds of years the Hebrew people had been forced into slavery. Pharaoh issued a death sentence for all baby boys.

My parents and sisters all came from Georgia to be a part of the service. I remember the many kind and encouraging words that were whispered in my ear that morning. 
