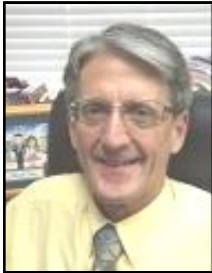

Dear Church Family and Friends,

There is power in asking a good question.
 How? Lowers stress. Helps you think clearly.
 Creates space for growth. This principle applies
 everywhere.

For example, suppose your parents are in a retirement home. They are having trouble taking care of themselves. You could rush them into assisted living. But that approach could create tension. Stress. Resistance.

The problem? You have decided, ahead of time, upon the answer.

A better approach? Ask good questions. Gather information. Include your parents in the process. Ask, "What are your concerns? How can I help you remain as independent as possible? What do you see as your part?"

See the difference? Keeps your mind open. Makes everyone partners in the decision. Shares responsibility. Honors their independence.

Jesus was the best at this skill. He asked a man who had been paralyzed for 38 years, "Do you want to get well?" The question seems cruel. But, for 38 years he had gotten used to being paralyzed. (John 5:5-6) It was a brilliant question. Only the paralyzed man could answer it.

Asking good questions is not easy. It requires thought. And practice. Try it. You will be glad you did.

Being a Refreshed and Refreshing Steward

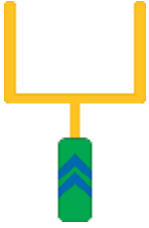

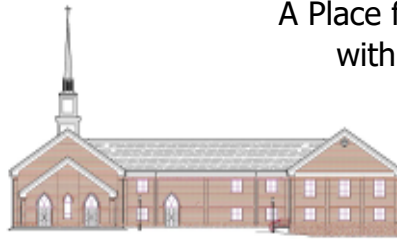
