

# WBC Music Ministry



When Butch died, we had a tremendous showing of friends and family both at our house and at the funeral home. It was great to see how many, and to hear stories of the impact he made on their lives. Prior to going to the funeral home, I told both of my girls to not take offense at anything that was said to them because people really didn't know what to say and they were trying to be caring. They were very glad that I did, because saying "He's in a better place" is not really helpful. We know he's in a better place, but we wanted him here with us, not somewhere else. That does give me comfort to know that he's in a better place, but immediately after he has died is not the time to tell me that. I had quite a bit of anger. Several people said "I don't know what to say to you to give you comfort, but I'm here for you", and they have been. This was the most comforting thing - being there after the fact.

Jane Hughes gave me a couple of books and I have been reading on them and one, in particular, helped me a lot and I hope it can help you to better support someone who is grieving. It is "It's OK That You're Not OK" by Megan Devine. Here are my best thoughts on what she has written and I've used her points to help you.

Grief looks different in everyone and you may not see it, you may not feel it, but grief is still with the one left behind. So, what do you do? What can you say?

Grief belongs to the griever. Don't start by telling them how to grieve or what they should be feeling. Any emotions they feel or things they need to do to help them grieve is ok as long as it's not life-threatening.

Stay present and state the truth. Don't try to tell them that this will pass because it won't. It will become a part of who they are and will change them - nothing will ever be the same and it will not pass.

Do not try to fix the unfixable. You cannot take their pain away, so don't even attempt to do that, just let your friend/family learn to live with that pain and be there to help them.

Be willing to witness searing, unbearable pain. Grief is not pretty. Pain is not pretty, but allow them to learn on you; don't try to fix it.
