

Mike's sermon series is on Jesus' parables and this Sunday, it comes from Luke 15. This includes the Prodigal Son, the lost sheep and the Woman with 10 coins.

The woman with 10 coins is the scripture for this coming Sunday and I have read it and thought upon it for the last few days. This parable is often interpreted as a representation of God's relentless pursuit of those who are lost. Each coin symbolizes a person, and the woman's tireless search reflects God's unwavering effort to bring people back into His fold. The joy she experiences upon finding the lost coin mirrors the heavenly celebration over a sinner who repents. This story highlights themes of perseverance, the value of each individual, and the boundless joy that accompanies redemption.

What have you lost? Have you lost your zest for life? The zing in your marriage? The kindness in your heart? Close ties with your family?
