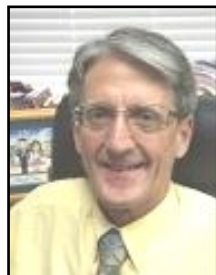

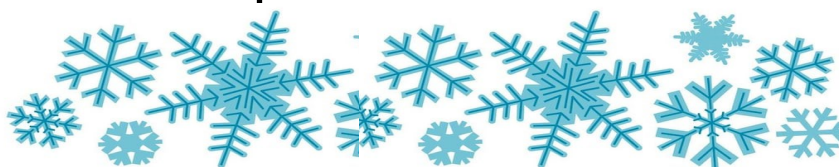

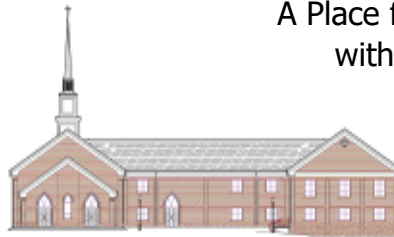
Responsibility

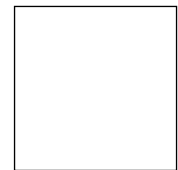
