# WBC Music Ministry



The last 3 weeks, my articles have been on how to continue growing as a Christian in your older years. The last 3 points are: Read and/or Listen to Scripture, Take Leadership, and Pray.

As Christians, we should always be reading scripture, even if it is only one verse each day. We need to set a time apart from our regular day to accomplish this. It might take a while to make it a habit, but if we really concentrate on it, it can be done. The Bible reads a little differently to you as an older adult than it did when you were a child, teen or even young adult.

If you haven't participated in the different activities we've had over the years of Reading the Bible Through in a Year or the Deep Dive study of highlighted passages that Pastor Mike has done, there are many programs that will help you with that. If your eyesight limits your reading, or you are driving to/from somewhere, listen to the Bible. You can access it on your cell phone, iPad, Kindle or other reading device, or tune in to different Biblical podcasts on your favorite listening device.

Take a leadership role in different programs within and outside of our church. It gets really old for the same people to HAVE to lead when there are so many within our ranks that could just as easily lead if they would just step up to do so. Pick something you are interested in and get involved, volunteer.

With all of these ways to continue to grow, the most important is to pray. Pray for God to give you the opportunity to lead, to share your faith, to grow your faith, to be involved with people or a different generation, who were raised differently than you, to have opportunities arise that you can serve, that you can invest both emotionally and financially. God will open pathways for you to be your best self.
