Plus, I would like to train for and run in a few local 5k races.

Terry and I would like to be active members at Wise Baptist. We love serving with you. This time, however, it will be in a different way. More in the background. We want to help with the ministry to college students and mission projects. Maybe lead Marriage Enrichment retreats or teach ballroom dancing. Serve as Camp Bethel staff parents during the summer.

We are praying for the next chapter of the life of Wise Baptist Church, and we ask that you pray for us as well.

The Apostle Paul, as pastor at Philippi, had some words for his congregation. As your pastor, I share the same words with you. "Rejoice in the Lord always. I will say it again: Rejoice!" (Philippians 4:4)

Change is an inevitable part of life. It can be exciting, daunting, or even painful, but the Bible offers profound wisdom and encouragement for navigating life's transitions with faith and grace.

One of the most comforting truths in Scripture is that while the world around us shifts, God remains constant. Malachi 3:6 declares, "For I the Lord do not change." This assurance reminds us that no matter how uncertain life feels, we can anchor ourselves in God's unchanging character—His love, mercy, and faithfulness.

The Bible often portrays change as a catalyst for spiritual growth. Romans 12:2 encourages believers to be "transformed by the renewal of your mind."
