Dear Church Family & Friends.

Sometimes it is hard to figure out how the New Testament relates to the Old Testament. (From this point forward, I will call the Old Testament the Hebrew Bible.) It is harder to understand when Paul seems to say in Romans

7 that the Law gets in the way of knowing Jesus. (By Law, Paul means the first five books of the Hebrew Bible.)

Compare the relationship of the Hebrew Bible and the New Testament to an X-ray. The X-ray reveals a problem. But it cannot fix it. You still need the X-ray, because you cannot fix something until you know it is a problem.

Paul says the Law reveals the human sin problem. But it cannot fix that problem. Human beings cannot obey God's Law on their own. If we could have done that, we would have done it already! Then, it would have been unnecessary for lesus to come.

The Law reveals that problem to which lesus is the answer. lesus' forgiveness and power make it possible for us to live out God's teachings far more than ever before.

The problem is not with the Hebrew Bible. (After all, it was the Bible Jesus used). The problem is with misinterpretation of the Hebrew Bible. Jesus said, "Do not think I have not come to abolish the prophets...but Law and the fulfill them." (Matthew 5:17)

Don't be intimidated by the Hebrew Bible. Great resources are available to help us understand it better. You will receive a great blessing. Love. Pastor Mike




